Background: the <u>ISO Norm 59004</u> adopted in June 2024 is the formal implementation of the scientific concept of the 10R developped by Julian Kirschherr.



Refuse: avoid producing and buying unnecessary products;

Rethink: questioning the potential environmental impact of a product throughout its life cycle before producing (includes recyclability of the materials);

Reduce: developing more efficient consumption patterns;

Reuse: reusing products for a second purpose;

Repair: designing the products that can easily be repaired;

Refurbish: restoring and modernising an old object to make it as new as possible again, by changing some parts and pieces;

Remanufacture: completely rebuilding an object for refurbishing;

Repurpose: redefine a new destination for the object - creatively finding new uses for items that might otherwise be discarded;

Recycle: recover materials from waste to reintroduce them into the production cycle;

Recover: recover energy or molecules from non-recyclable waste.
