

SPOTLIGHT ON THE LAND TO SEA CONTINUUM TO PROTECT MARINE ENVIRONMENTS FROM PLASTIC POLLUTION

Organised by AFD, French Solid Waste Partnership, ADEME, Circulearth

Pollutions travel on the continuum from land to sea: 80% of plastic pollution in oceans originates on land. In island territories, these transfers are particularly blatant.

Establishing waste management systems is key to control these pollutions and enable the transition to circularity through the enhanced knowledge of the waste stream.

Examples and solutions from the Mekong River, Mediterranean region and Small Island States will be shared, followed by the celebration of the success of the Clean Ocean Initiative to track and enhance project financing by IFIs, along with the signature of its second phase.


