Integrating waste and resources management into national strategies to achieve global decarbonization.

The panellists will discuss the success factors and challenges of translating national strategies into local solutions to harness the potential of waste management toward decarbonization.

Our ability to manage waste is a transversal indicator of our ability to develop sustainably. Sound waste management aims to 1/ reduce the amount of waste and hence the use of resources, 2/ reduce the impact of waste collection and treatment, and 3/ to maximize the resources extracted from waste.

Reducing the amount of waste requires both circular supply chains to prevent waste throughout the production process and eco-conception of products to facilitate the recovery of materials in used products.

With this circular perspective waste management can significantly contribute to global decarbonization beyond the scope 1 emissions of the waste sector, since it is intrinsically tied to industries, resource extraction and use, and energy production. Harnessing this potential is an ambitious task that requires public and private stakeholders to play their part, orchestrated by a national strategy underlying adequate institutional organisation and financial schemes.
