Towards a sustainable urban transition in Lomé

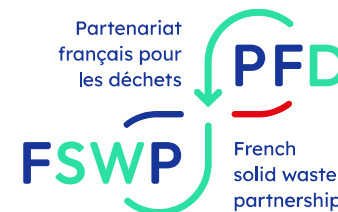
Holistic domestic waste management system in the Grand Lomé: 1.8 M people, 300,000 T/y of solid waste.

An ongoing multi-tranch project since 2006:



- Improvement of the holistic solid waste management system and capacity building support
- Implementation of engineered landfills with long term biogas and leachate management
- Strengthening recovery & recycling initiatives,
- Improvement of the sector financial resources
- Gradual increase of performance requirements
