Pole R, a local circular economy

A 16 000 m² site dedicated to reuse, repair, and waste reduction.

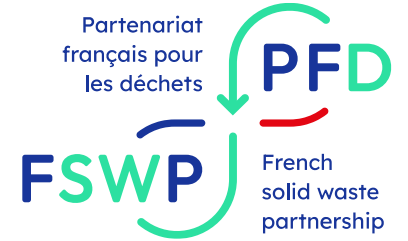


8,000 m² managed as a third place, with shared spaces, equipment, human resources, and material resources.

Three buildings:

- Anti-waste zone dedicated to food deposits,
- *Fabricanova* : a cooperative hosting platforms for sorting, reuse, repair, and upcycling;
- An incubator for new circular economy activities (textiles, sports and leisure items, wood).

BENEFIT:

- > Target of a 20% annual reduction in the volume of waste produced in the region.
- > 20% reuse and repair rate (7,500 tons).
- > 40 000 packaging items avoided.

CO-BENEFIT:

- > Territorial cooperation between local authorities, the social and solidarity economy, industry, research, environmental associations, etc.
- > A thriving local economy
- > Accessibility for residents: drop-offs and purchases of reclaimed materials.
